


INTRODUCTION:


DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

















































- Guidance and mentoring play a vital role in the development of students learning process. It was found that, Majority students were satisfied with guidance and mentoring by the teachers in the college. It is recommended to the teachers to improve the guidance and mentoring process.
- It was observed that, over 80% students feel the overall effectiveness of the teacher was good. There is a scope for further improvement here and hence it is recommended to the teachers to enhance their overall effectiveness.
- 3. It was found that students have said that, the teacher's knowledge on usage of ICT was good. But some of the students feel that, improvements are required in enhancing knowledge on usage of ICT of the teacher. Hence, it is recommended to the college, to provide necessary ICT usage training to the teachers as and when required to improve the ICT enabled learning in the college.
- 4. It was found that, majority students feel that, the teacher's regularity to class was good. Therefore, it was recommended to the teacher's that, they should maintain the regularity and improve it to satisfy remaining students.
